



WEST SYDNEY WOLVES BASKETBALL ASSOCIATION CHILD PROTECTION, HARRASSMENT & DISCRIMINATION POLICY

West Sydney Wolves Basketball Association has adopted the Australian Sports Commission Play by the Rules Child Protection – Harassment and Discrimination guidelines.

Play by the Rules is supported by the Federal, State and Territory Governments of Australia.

Child protection in sport and recreation starts with setting up an environment and administrative system that will allow children (anyone under 18) to remain safe from abuse and protected from any individual who wishes to exploit or harm them.

Child abuse can occur through actions that harm or injure a child, or an environment that does not provide protection for them.

Child abuse can be intentional (such as physical, emotional, verbal or sexual abuse) or unintentional (such as an injury caused through poorly maintained facilities and equipment).

West Sydney Wolves Basketball Association promotes a child safe environment and has a 'whole-club' approach with policies and procedures for dealing with abuse, personal responsibilities and the spectrum of behaviours when it comes to child safety.
